JOB TITLE: Academic Coach for Mathematics—Secondary

# **Qualifications**:

- WV Professional Teaching Certificate
- Endorsement in Mathematics 7-12
- Five or more years of successful teaching experience required.
- Proven ability to model instructional best practices and mentor other teachers.
- Working knowledge and experience in working with data and test analysis.
- Experience with developing and presenting staff development programs.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Ability to use technology to present, communicate, organize and disseminate information.
- Additional Minimum Requirements: Applicants who have recent unsatisfactory evaluations will not be considered
  eligible for consideration; applicants who demonstrate unsatisfactory interview performance are not eligible for
  consideration; and, applicants who receive unfavorable reference recommendations will not be eligible for consideration.
- Additional Minimum Requirements for Applicants Not Currently Employed: Applicants who have been dismissed or who
  have had their contracts non-renewed for cause by another school district are not eligible for consideration;

### **Duties Responsibilities:**

#### **Mathematics Coach**

- 1. Mentors and coaches secondary (7-12) mathematics teachers for the purpose of building capacity to teach and improve Mathematics instruction as it relates to implementation of best practices intended to improve student learning.
- 2. Assesses skills and needs (both initially and ongoing) of teachers and students within a school setting for the purpose of determining the kinds of professional development and strategies needed to bring about student achievement and gains in in mathematics.
- 3. Prepares lesson plans, in collaboration with teachers, related to mathematics at the secondary level for the purpose of differentiating instruction and adhering to guides and district curriculum.
- 4. Researches and prepares a variety of written and electronic materials (e.g. lesson plans, guides, classroom materials, reports, etc.) for the purpose of demonstrating best practices in math instruction, documenting activities, providing written reference, and/or conveying information.
- 5. Leads and participates in on-going and job-embedded professional development (e.g. meetings, workshops, trainings, and seminars) for the purpose of conveying and/or gathering information related to math content knowledge, pedagogy, and coaching.
- 6. Assists instructional staff with planning and implementation of curriculum.
- 7. Assists with the selection of supplemental programs/materials.
- 8. Provide oversight for school improvement activities and state initiatives in mathematics.

- 9. Assists with the planning and implementation professional development designed to meet defined needs of the Grant County Federal Programs.
- 10. Analyzes class and grade level data in mathematics at assigned schools/grade levels for the purpose of sharing information with teachers and making informed decisions relative to instructional practices.
- 11. Develops and/or presents professional development programs.
- 12. Maintains a variety of manual and electronic files and/or records (e.g. school/class data, student data, other data regarding math proficiency etc.) for the purpose of determining success of math coaching on student achievement.
- 13. Applies assessment instruments; plans and manages projects; and uses pertinent software applications.
- 14. Uses technology to present, communicate, organize and disseminate information.
- 15. Visits schools and coach in classrooms on a scheduled basis.
- 16. Perform other job-related duties as assigned by supervisor.
