JOB DESCRIPTION

JOB TITLE: Sanitation Plant Operator

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or GED
- WV Div. of Labor Certified Wastewater Operator, Minimum Class S
- Additional Minimum Requirements: Applicants who have recent unsatisfactory evaluations will not be considered
 eligible for consideration; applicants who demonstrate unsatisfactory interview performance are not eligible for
 consideration; and, applicants who receive unfavorable reference recommendations will not be eligible for
 consideration.
- Additional Minimum Requirements for Applicants Not Currently Employed: Applicants who have been dismissed or who have had their contracts non-renewed for cause by another school district are not eligible for consideration;
- The ability to perform the job duties and responsibilities of the position as contained in the Job Description, with or without reasonable accommodation

CLASSIFICATIONS:

Sanitation plant operator: a person employed to operate and maintain a water or sewage treatment plant to ensure the safety of the plant's effluent for human consumption or environmental protection;

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES

- Add chemicals, such as ammonia or chlorine, to disinfect water or other liquids

- Monitor operating conditions, meters, and gauges
- Collect and test water and sewage samples
- Record meter and gauge readings and operational data
- Operate equipment to purify and clarify water or to process or dispose of sewage
- Clean and maintain equipment, tanks, filter beds, and other work areas
- Follow U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations
- Ensure safety standards are met
- Other duties as reasonably assigned by supervisor
